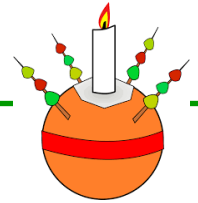


RE Day 11th December 2018

Year 3: Why the Star?

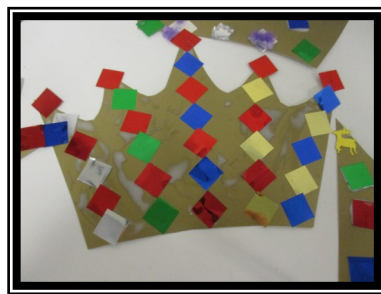
Year 4: Why Herod?
